• **APT1 Scavenger Hunt Data** View: Contains the data used for Synapse's "APT1 Scavenger Hunt". The Scavenger Hunt uses Mandiant's APT1 report to help you



learn Synapse - both the Optic UI and / or the Storm query language - with a series of questions ("challenges").

The data includes IOCs and other information from data from sources such as MISP, AlienVault/LevelBlue, CISA's Known Exploited Vulnerabilities, MITRE ATT&CK, the TOR Project, and more.
