Power-Ups



Power-Ups

- Packages / services that add functionality to Synapse
- Many act as connectors to various data sources
 - Third-party data providers
 - Common databases (synapse-sidepocket)
 - Logging systems (synapse-datadog)
 - Ticketing systems (synapse-jira)
 - Public DNS / Whois services (synapse-nettools)
- Some provide functionality
 - YARA Grid, File Parser, RSS, Search...
- Rapid vs. Advanced Power-Ups



Power-Ups

- Published via Power-Ups Tool
 - Available, installed, updates
- Can browse all Power-Ups
 - Bootcamp demo instances list available rapid Power-Ups
- Power-Up requirements vary
 - Some are free
 - Some require API keys (free, paid...)
 - API keys may provide varying levels of access
- Generally installed and managed by your DevOps team

You can install and test any available Power-Up in your demo instance! (API key may be required.)
